

# Comprehensive Scholarship Program

## General

1. Everyone's schedules need to be posted on their doors for scholastic purposes as well as for others to know when you are in class.
2. Everyone's schedule shall be updated on BSYlab 3 by the second meeting of the semester
3. 23.5 hour quiet hours start the Sunday before Dead Week and last through the completion of the semester. Loud half hour shall be between 10:00 and 10:30 p.m.
4. Quiet hours are between 7:00 pm – 7:00 am Sunday night through Friday morning.
5. No games are allowed on the house computers at any time.
6. Any actions in direct conflict with Scholarship policy will result in disciplinary actions deemed appropriate by chapter's executive board.
7. GPA goals will be set at the second meeting of the semester.

## Study Hours

1. Mandatory house study hours are Sunday-Thursday night from 7-10pm.
2. Playing computer games, video games, watching T.V. on 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> floors is not allowed.

## Television

1. Cable television is not allowed on second and third floors.
2. Televisions are not allowed to be on in a room during study hours.

## New Members

1. Scholarship Chair will be responsible for meeting with all new members once a week for the first three weeks of class. (Week of August 21, August 28, September 4)
2. Scholarship Chair is expected to keep records of new member's goals, time management sheets, and grade status sheets.

## Peer Review Board (PRB)

1. PRB shall consist of the President, First Vice President and Scholarship Chair.
2. PRB will be held at the beginning of the semester and the week after midterms are released.
3. Pledge Fathers are invited when their son is required to attend.
4. Anyone who receives less than a 2.40 GPA the previous semester must appear before PRB to explain their plan to improve their grades.
5. Members who receive a midterm must appear before PRB to explain their plan to improve their grades.
6. PRB shall be full formal attire

## Study Tables

1. Study Tables will be determined during PRB by formula as design by scholarship chair.
2. All members receiving a midterm(s) shall be placed on mandatory study tables for the remainder of the semester.
3. All members who did not attaining a 2.40 GPA the previous semester shall be placed on mandatory study tables until midterms are issued.
4. All members on study tables are also responsible for keeping a record of their grades of every class. Records will be turned in along with study tables as noted below.
5. Study hours will be recorded weekly and turned into scholarship chair by Saturday at 5pm.
6. Freshmen out-of-house will be required to turn in study tables and grade records at regular chapter meetings.
7. Study hours must be completed under the supervision of a proctor designated by the scholarship chair during study hours if the member fails to turn in their required study hours.
8. Scholarship chair reserves the right to proctor study hours for any member of the chapter.

## Fines

1. Schedule is not attached to door two (2) weeks after classes start until finals week. \$5
2. Classes are not update on BSYlab 3 by second meeting of semester \$5
3. Watching TV, playing video games, or computer games during study hours on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floor \$10
4. Study table not turned in by 5pm on Saturday \$1

## Study Locations

1. The computer room, chapter lounge, the Darryl Jahn library, and the chapter apartment are designated as study rooms and are subject to the following conditions during all hours unless noted otherwise.

    - ii. Keep talking to a minimum
    - iii. No food is allowed
