SPRING 2002 PHON-A-THON A SUCCESS!

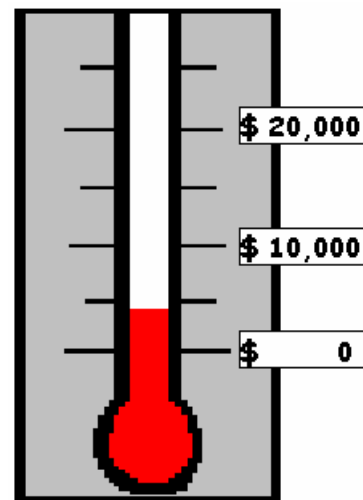
